This session introduces participants to RefWorks, a web-based citation management software program that simplifies the task of formatting references according to a citation style of choice (i.e., APA, MLA, Chicago) and automatically inserts the formatted reference into a document. RefWorks will keep track of the references/citations imported from the library's catalogue, online article indexes, and databases, as well as those manually imported.

- Develop the ability to organize their research.
- Bring resources from multiple databases into one, easily accessible tool.
